

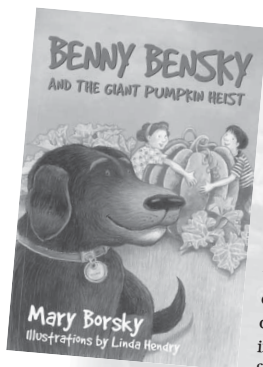
Benny Bensky and the Giant Pumpkin Heist
